Targeted Courses


Research-based classes to address the needs of your staff and the child. Courses are registry-accredited.

Technical Assistance

A qualified child care expert will visit your program. They observe the child and can help you optimize the classroom environment to make life easier for you and the child.

Child Mental Health Consultation

A mental health consultant will observe the child in your program, and help staff and parents develop routines to settle the child. A consultant may refer the child for developmental testing or connect the family with community resources.


